#### DO YOU KNOW WHAT IS COOKING IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD?

- \* Pay attention to what you see near trash collection sites and in your streets and sidewalks. Lithium batteries, cold and allergy medications, camping fuels, stained coffee filters, and fertilizer are dangerous when combined.
- \* Be aware of strong chemical odors.



#### WHAT IS THIS GOING TO COST US?

- \* Drug use has an enormous cost to our neighborhoods which destroys property values and leads to blight.
- \* Using drugs creates physically and mentally ill residents in our community. Medical, rehabilitation, emergency room visits, and disease control costs are astronomical to treat addicts.
- \* Public safety costs are increased as we investigate, prosecute, and incarcerate offenders of drug crimes.
- \* Welfare costs and unemployment costs increase.
- \* Crimes of violence, along with child abuse and neglect, increase in homes of drug use.



#### DO YOU KNOW THE PEOPLE IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD?



- \* Get to know your neighbors, including their children.
- \* Be conscious of suspicious activities and constant quick-stop visitors.
- \* Call authorities immediately if you see violent or delusional people.
